



## Dog Sledding/Tubing

<b><u>Dates</u></b>	Saturday, February 15 <sup>th</sup> 2025 (Cancel Deadline is January 31 <sup>st</sup> , 2025)
<b><u>Description</u></b>	<p>This dog sledding trip in the Swan River Valley near Breckenridge runs along a 6 mile loop. Each tour begins with an introduction of the guides and how the sled team works. This is a unique and thrilling way to experience dog sledding and the Rocky Mountains. <b>Tubing will be our first activity, followed by dog sledding.</b> Transportation, dog sledding and tubing are included with this program.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>Cost: \$310/person, R4R Cost: \$110/person</b></p> <p>Must be 5 years or older for this trip. Cancellation/ sign up deadline is January 31<sup>st</sup>.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">-----</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Dogsledding Restrictions: Must be 5 years or older.</p> <p>Tubing Restrictions: Riders must be at least 36" tall and able to ride alone in a tube. Children ages 6 and under must be accompanied by an adult.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Sign up/cancelation deadline is the Friday, two week prior to the trip date.</p>

<b><u>Itinerary</u></b>	<p><b>0630:</b> Meet at outdoor Recreation</p> <p>0630-0645: Waivers, Load Bus</p> <p>0645: Depart Peterson Outdoor Recreation</p> <p>0645-0945: Transportation to Dogsledding/Tubing, one 10 min pit stop on the way.</p> <p>1000-1400: Tubing and dogsledding</p> <p>1400-1630: Transportation back to Peterson Outdoor Recreation</p>
<b><u>Preparation</u></b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Proper clothing includes water resistant pants and jacket, synthetic layers, waterproof gloves, neck gator, wool socks, and snow boots. We do not recommend wearing any clothing that retains water, i.e., cotton, jean material.</li> </ul>

<p><b><u>Policies</u></b></p>	<p><b><u>Policies:</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-If participant cancels after sign-up cancelation deadline, no refund will be issued.</li> <li>-Transfers to another program after the sign-up/cancelation deadline are considered cancellations. The new enrollment will require payment in full to be made.</li> <li>-<u>Eligibility:</u> All active duty military, including reserves and national guard, DoD employees, their dependents and up to five additional non-military affiliated guests are welcome to participate in any Outdoor Adventure Program.</li> <li>-<u>Recharge for Resiliency (R4R)</u> Includes- Single Airman Program (SAPI), RecOn, Deployed Affected Program (DAP)</li> </ul> <p style="padding-left: 40px;"><u>Eligibility for R4R programs:</u> Funding supports Active Duty and Reserve members, to include their families (dependents), at each installation. Retirees, civilians, and foreign military are not eligible for R4R discounted rates. Other U.S. military are not eligible unless they are a part of an Air Force-led joint-based scenario or are permanently assigned to an Air force/Space Force installation.</p>
