TRANSPORTATION	<p>Morning Busses load: 5:30a.m. (6am firm departure) TBD, Peterson SFB, CO 80916</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • There will be multiple buses, ensure you get on the correct one. ODR staff will be present to assist. • Restrooms will be open within the RP Lee Youth Center prior to departure. The bus will have restroom facilities, additional stops are not scheduled. • Food and beverages are allowed on the bus. Please, no glass containers. • It is recommended to bring a day pack for any "must have" items throughout the day. The bus drivers will have a set time they will be at the bus. Monarch has lockers available for rent inside their main lodge area. • Busses load: 3:30p.m. (4p.m. firm departure)
LIFT TICKETS	<p>Lift tickets will be available for pick-up starting at 8:30a.m. (not available before 8:30a.m.) at the Winter Adventure Day Hospitality Area, signs will direct you.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Monarch Lifts open at 9:00a.m.
LESSONS/RENTALS	<p>Location: Monarch Mountain, 23715 W. US Highway 50, Monarch, CO 81201 Check in at the hospitality area: 8:30a.m. (lesson begins promptly at 9:30a.m.)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Must sign waiver prior to participation in lessons & rental equipment (QR code): • Monarch Mountain online waiver must be completed by COB 13 FEB (see QR Code) • All Lesson participants must meet at the Winter Adventure Day (WAD) Hospitality Area to pick up their lift ticket prior to proceeding to check in for lesson. • All participants 17 and younger will be required to fill out a post lesson release authorization tag to be attached to child's jacket (release tags will be provided at Hospitality area). • Eligible participants must be ages 7 and up 
TUBING	<p>Location: Monarch Mountain, 23715 W. US Highway 50, Monarch, CO 81201 Tubing Yurt is located a short walk above the Rental & Lesson Center</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Check in @ Yurt 15min prior to your scheduled time to watch the mandatory safety video. • Must sign waiver prior to participation (QR Code). • Monarch Mountain online waiver must be completed by COB 13 FEB. • Riders must be at least 36" tall and able to ride alone in a tube. • Children age 6 and under must be accompanied by a participating adult (in a separate tube). • Tubing sessions are one hour long. • What to wear: Be sure to wear warm clothing and a waterproof outer jacket, snow pants or weatherproof shell, warm footwear with a good tread, waterproof gloves or mittens, a hat or helmet, eye protection and sunscreen. If you're dressed for skiing or snowboarding then you're already good to go! 
SNOWMOBILING	<p>Location: Monarch Snowmobile Tours, 22763 Highway 50, Garfield/Monarch, CO 81227</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Arrive @ 12:30p.m. (1p.m. sled departure) • Snowmobiling participants that signed up for transportation should ensure they get on the correct bus in the morning. • Transportation from Monarch base area to afternoon snowmobiling will depart at 11:45pm from base area right below the Gunbarrel ski run.
SNOWSHOEING	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Snowshoeing will meet at the base of the Gunbarrel Ski Run at 12:30p.m. All equipment will be provided on site. Snowshoeing route at Old Monarch Pass, 2.6 miles +380ft of elevation gain.
PREPARATION	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Proper ski clothing includes water resistant pants and jacket, synthetic layers, waterproof gloves and wool socks. We recommend purchasing goggles and a buff to keep the wind off your face and out of your eyes. We do not recommend wearing any clothing that retains water, i.e. cotton, jean material. Jackets and Pants can be rented from Peterson Outdoor Recreation on a first come first serve basis.

PACKING LIST	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Skis/snowboard • Ski boots/ snowboard boots • Poles • Goggles/ eye protection • Gloves • Buff or face mask for wind protection while skiing. • Ski jacket • Ski pants • Additional layers • Wool socks • Snow boots (if signed up for snowshoeing) • Water • Sunscreen/ChapStick • Snacks for the drive/ entertainment for the drive • Small day pack to carry any must-have items you don't want to wear. • Lunch if you don't plan on eating at the cafeteria/lodge (driver will set a time frame when the bus will be available to grab items) • Lockers are available at Monarch
FOOD	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • You are welcome to bring your own sack lunch, snacks and beverages. It's a great way to save a few dollars on the mountain. Enjoy a tailgate lunch or warm up inside the buses. Please, no glass containers on the buses. (driver will set a time frame when the bus will be available to grab items) • If you bring your own lunch, we ask that you, please, do not eat your sack lunch inside the lodge. • Monarch has a great selection of food and drink options Visit https://skimonarch.com/dining/ to see food vendors and their menus.
