<p>Itinerary</p>	<p>Trip itinerary: 0700: Meet @ Outdoor Recreation 0700- 0715: Waiver and gear fitting 0715-1000 (Approx): Load up Van and start driving to the Reservoir 1000: Arrive at Dillon Reservoir, Begin Prepping Gear 1030: Approx. time arrive at put in 1230: Approx. time take off reservoir 1230-1300: Pack up and Begin drive to Breckenridge, CO 1330: Arrive in Downtown Breckenridge, CO 1330- 1500: Explore/Shop, Lunch in Breckenridge, CO (Lunch is not included in trip price) 1500 - 1515: Load into the Van to Drive Back 1530 - 1800 (Approx): Drive back to Peterson ODR **Please understand that all times are approximate, they can range dramatically depending on the flow of the river**</p>

<p>Recommendations for customers to bring</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Appropriate clothing (synthetic clothes / quick drying are best, UPF clothing recommended) ● Change of clothes for after SUPPING,

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● CLOSED TOED SHOES WITH A HEEL STRAP, no flip flops and/or Crocs. If you don't have water shoes an old pair of tennis shoes will work. ● Sunglasses WITH a retainer strap ● Sunscreen ● Water bottle with a durable strap/attachment point if you wish to bring it on the water. ● Small Day pack for items/ change of clothes ● Towel ● Lunch/Snacks ● Please leave all jewelry at home, including wedding bands or anything of value you do not want to lose.
<u>Don't Bring</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● drugs and alcohol, ● pets ● Do Not recommend wearing cotton or denim
<u>Understand the Risk</u>	<p>You must be able to swim to participate in this trip. Quality trips depend largely on the skill and personality of the guide. All of the guides are well trained and have First Aid & CPR certifications and activity specific training.
